Honors and Academic students will be in the same class section for Anatomy and Physiology. There will be similar assignments as the basics just need to be learned by both classes but honors students will be held to a deeper level of understanding, higher level of response, and will have additional assignments/projects that the academic students will not be asked to complete. Academic students will be required to maintain their notebook throughout the school year to help teach good study habits while honors students can maintain their notebook if they choose but will not be required to maintain it.

The guidelines for that will be sent home for a signature and then will be located in the front of your student's notebook for the remainder of the year.
