This notebook will reflect a substantial portion of your student's grade because it contains <u>all</u> of our notes, lab work, classwork, and homework.

99% of the time students fail, it is due to incomplete homework. Making sure that all work is complete in their notebook on a nightly basis is a great way to make sure they are on track. The guidelines for that will be sent home for a signature and then will be located in the front of your student's notebook for the remainder of the year. If your student is struggling, please find time to review their notebook regularly to help keep them on track. The notebook table of contents can be found at **bradylong.weeebly.com**. We recommend bookmarking this page for the school year. It can also be found on your student's google classroom.
