

## Standards - Unit 2: Homeostasis

Standards are the things the State of California says you need to learn while taking a class. Living Earth has a large number of standards the state says you need to learn. ### LS1.A: Structure and Function

- a. Feedback mechanisms maintain a living system's internal conditions within certain limits and mediate behaviors, allowing it to remain alive and functional even as external conditions change within some range. Feedback mechanisms can encourage (through positive feedback) or discourage (negative feedback) what is going on inside the living system.
- b. Multicellular organisms have a hierarchical structural organization, in which any one system is made up of numerous parts and is itself a component of the next level.
